Details

At the moment the university does not require departments to show if their lecturers are up to date on training, nor if they take any of the information in and know it. My idea is for departments to have lecturers fill in some form of questionnaire about the training they receive, so that they are aware of what is known and what isn't. As it is there are instances where departments reason away lecturers failing to aid disabled students and they haven't been trained or don't know the information. If it was implemented that lecturers were to prove what they know and don't know so that they got the appropriate training, departments would not be able to excuse discriminatory behaviour.
